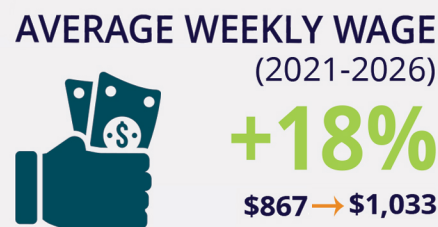
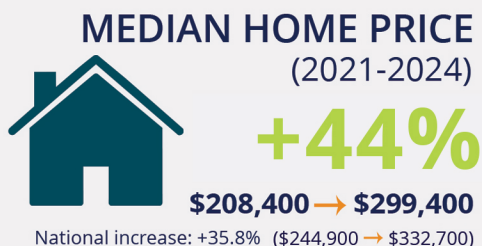


RISING COSTS

FAMILIES WAITING FOR HOUSING HELP

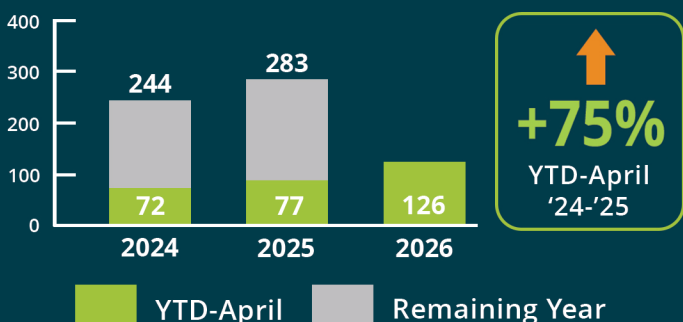


3,835 families are on the Pennington County Housing Vouchers waitlist. Estimated wait is over 2.5 years.

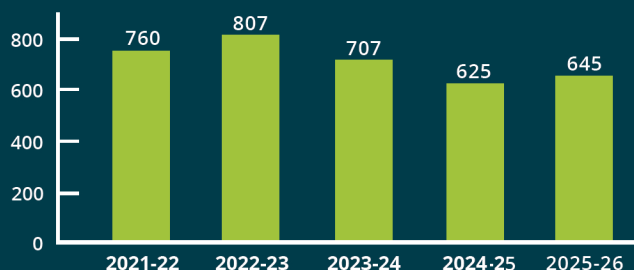
OTHER SIGNS OF HOUSING NEED
